## **Regular Meeting Minutes**

### **CALL TO ORDER**

## **REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR**

Scott Schoolcraft presented a written report.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- A. Attorney Mark Nettleton was introduced to the NKSA board. Mark is an experienced municipal attorney from the law firm of Mika Meyers.
- B. The board discussed the PARCC-Side CWP Six Year Improvement Plan. The proposed plan will encompass a proactive equipment replacement approach that will also include growth factors. Bonds are expected to be paid off in 2031-32.

Mark Prein presented a master approach timeline that puts the recommended work to be performed in sequenced order. The plan timeline considers efficiency as well as minimizing construction costs. The board confirmed their interest and support in continuing to move forward with the plan.

C. Scott Schoolcraft updated the board on the high BOD loading investigations. Scott is receiving cooperation from local law enforcement. Any reports of suspicious activity pertaining to this matter should be shared with Scott.
